(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2018

For the safety of the public and workforce during works to improve bus stops and change speed limit signs, Kent County Council has made an Order to impose a temporary mandatory speed limit of 40 mph on a section of A257 Gobery Hill, Wingham / Roman Road, Shatterling, in the Dover area.

The compulsory speed limit of 40 mph will be imposed in both directions on A257 Gobery Hill / Roman Road, from the junction with Preston Hill eastwards to the junction with Pedding Lane.

This applies from Monday 29 January 2018, for works with estimated completion by 16 February 2018.

The Speed Limit applies as and when the relevant signs are clearly displayed on site. This is in conjunction with temporary traffic lights whilst works are being carried out.
