B2046 HIGH STREET, WINGHAM

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER OCTOBER 2018

To allow excavations to be carried out to repair a sewer in the carriageway, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of B2046 High Street, Wingham, in the Dover area.

An overnight closure is planned for Wednesday 31 October 2018 from 19:00 hours through until approximately 06:00 hours.

B2046 High Street will be closed north of the junction with Staple Road, with no through access between the junctions with A257 Canterbury Road and Staple Road

The alternative route for all through traffic is via A2046 Adisham Road, Box Iron Road, Barham Interchange, A2 Dover Road, A2050 Dover Road, New Dover Road, A257 Lower Chantry Lane, Longport, St Martin's Hill, Littlebourne Road, Canterbury Road, The Hill, High Street (Littlebourne), Wingham Road, and Canterbury Road back to High Street.

Local access to the remainder of the B2046 continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed, and Staple Road can be reached from a southern direction.
